

Biography

Seru is a dream pop act from Johannesburg South Africa. Seru was formed late 2017 by producer Steven Hogg (Vox Portent) and vocalist Jade Fortune. For most of late 2017 and early 2018 the duo focused on building their indie, electronic, dream-wave sound. Influenced by the likes of Baths, Blue Hawaii, Braids, Grimes and Jamie XX, they began recording a demo EP in their respective home studios.
