

Tech Rider for Vox Portent

Gear:

- Akai APC40 Mk 2
- PC/Laptop
- M-Audio MobilePre Soundcard
- MikroKorg XL Synthesizer
- Double keyboard stand

Sound setup:

The sound setup for Vox Portent requires two inputs to go into a DJ mixer. *Please make sure there is enough space on stage for keyboard stand and space for laptop on and soundcard on DJ table.* Here's a breakdown of the gear used:

- Akai APC40 Mk 2: This is a MIDI controller that is used by Vox Portent to trigger and control clips in Ableton Live software.
- PC/Laptop: Vox Portent uses a PC/laptop to run Ableton Live software.
- M-Audio MobilePre Soundcard: This is a compact USB audio interface that Vox Portent uses to connect the PC/laptop to the DJ mixer. The artist uses these inputs to plug in microphones, instruments, or other audio sources.
- MikroKorg XL Synthesizer: This is a compact analog modeling synthesizer that is used by Vox Portent to create and control synth sounds.
- Double keyboard stand: This is the stand used by Vox Portent to hold both the Akai APC40 Mk 2 and the MikroKorg XL synthesizer.

- 2x bottles of still water
